

CORNHILL COMMUNITY ACTION GROUP

Cornhill Community Action Group aims to identify and implement projects for the benefit of the parish of Cornhill-on-Tweed.

The Group started in 2017, and projects started in that year include:

- Community walks, which are led walks using public footpaths, for anyone who wishes to enjoy the countryside, meet others and learn more about the history, geography and geology of the area around Cornhill;
- Collaboration with Bell View so as to provide additional social occasions for villagers;
- Installation of festive lighting boxes, to light up the Village, especially, but not exclusively, at Christmas and New Year;
- Developing the Churchyard of St. Helen's Church into a community space.

These are ongoing in 2018, and additional projects for this year are:

- A Summer Fair, the time and location of which will become the model for Fairs in subsequent years; and
- Talks about the local area.

A project to document the social history of Cornhill may be added to this list.

The Group would welcome suggestions from members of the community, of other projects that could be undertaken. The intention is that any project will generate an identifiable benefit specifically for Cornhill-on-Tweed.

The Steering Committee is currently made up of representatives of:

- Cornhill Parish Council;
- St. Helen's Church;
- The Village Shop;
- The Village Hall.

In order to fully represent all aspects of village life, it is hoped to attract representatives of other businesses and community groups.

The activities of the Group are reported to and formally minuted by the Parish Council. Funds raised are held by the Parish Council and recorded in its financial statements.

Information about its activities will be posted in the Village Newsletter, on the website and the Notice Board; other information channels will be added going forward.
